### The National Education Policy (NEP)

In July 2020, the Union Cabinet signed off on an agreement that aims to universalise education in India from preschool to secondary level. The proposed reform is set to transform millions of Indian lives.

### Goal of the NEP

The main goal of the NEP is to replace rote learning with context-based learning. This will create a pool of versatile, proficient and well-rounded individuals equipped with 21st-century skills, who will enable India to become a superpower. At Mahattattva, our goal is educational transformation. Our philosophy is derived from the long-standing principle that equipping students with contemporary strategies and tools leads to educational enrichment within the classroom, in turn helping students to prepare for the real world.

## What Does the NEP Mean for Schools?



The NEP is specifically designed to create sweeping changes in the current schooling system and in higher education. Key changes include:

- ✓ Restructuring of the school system to a 5+3+3+4 model corresponding to the age groups 3-8 years (foundational stage), 8-11 (preparatory), 11-14 (middle), and 14-18 (secondary); this, in turn, will result in an overhaul of the existing grade structure, curriculum and progression.
- ✓ A focus on the foundational years, including a mixed approach that combines activity-based play and light textbooks, targeting an interactive classroom environment.
- ✓ A focus on the holistic development of learners, creating space for critical thinking as well as learning based on inquiry, discovery, discussion, and analysis rather than rote memorization.

- Promotion of Indian languages, arts & culture
- Less text-based content and more enriching, interactive learning opportunities for the students
- Synergy in curriculum across all levels of education
- Integrating design thinking into the curriculum
- Promotion of a DIY mind-set and project-based learning
- Upskilling teachers through learning programmes as part of their professional development
- Continuous review of progress to enhance classroom learning, supported by outstanding research on new strategies that work in the Indian context
- Highest quality education for all learners regardless of social or economic background through development of the creative potential of each individual

Focusing on holistic, age-appropriate development within education allows children to gain both analytical skills and practical life skills. The NEP aims to lay a solid groundwork for students across a variety of subjects, including reading, writing, speaking, physical education, art, languages, science, and mathematics.

By participating in hands-on learning experiences in each of these fields, students are able to develop their cognitive and creative skills much more effectively than via conventional educational methods. Active learning ensures that time spent in the classroom is both meaningful and memorable.

We partner with schools across the nation and implement bespoke strategies that cater to the unique characteristics of each community, introducing a new kind of education that empowers students to have fun while learning.




## Improvement of Learning Outcomes
